vision To John

Vision 1

1- The revelation of Yeshua [Isa] Christ, which Alaha [Allah] gave him to show his servants what would soon happen. He revealed it by sending his angel to his servant John.

2 Those who have testified to the word of Alaha [Allah] and to the testimony of Yeshua [Isa] Christ concerning all that he has seen.

3 Blessed is the one who reads the words of this prophecy, and blessed is the one who hears them and keeps what is written in them, because the time is near.

4 John, to the seven churches in Asia: Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is

to come, and from the seven spirits before His
throne.

5 Through Yeshua [Isa] Christ, the faithful witness,
the firstborn from the dead, and King of the kings of
the earth. To Him belongs the love of Him who has
washed us from our sins by His blood.

6 And He made us a kingdom and priests to His
Alaha [Allah] and Father. To Him be glory and
dominion forever and ever. Amen.

7 Look, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye
will see him, even those who pierced him; and all the
peoples of the earth will mourn because of him.
Amen.

8 “I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and
the end,” says the Lord, who is, who was, and who
is to come, the Almighty.

9 I am John, your brother and partner in the
tribulation, the kingdom, and the sufferings of
Yeshua [Isa] Christ. I was on the island of Patmos
for the word of Alaha [Allah] and the testimony of
Yeshua [Isa] Christ.

10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and I heard behind me a loud voice like the sound of a trumpet.

11 He said, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last. Write what you see in a book and send it to the seven churches in Asia: Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia, and Laodicea."

12 Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking to me. When I turned, I saw seven golden lampstands.

13 In the midst of the seven lampstands stood a man who looked like the Son of Man, wearing a robe that reached to his feet and a golden belt around his waist.

14 His head and hair were white as wool, white as snow, and his eyes were like burning fire.

15 His feet were like burnished copper, as if they had been heated in a furnace. And his voice was like the sound of running water.

16 In his right hand were seven stars, and out of his mouth came a sharp, two-edged sword. His face was like the sun in its full glory.

17 When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. He laid his right hand on me and said, “Do not be afraid; I am the first and the last.”

The Living One. I was dead, and now I am alive forever! Amen. And I hold the keys to Hades and Death.

So write down what you saw, what is happening now, and what will happen later.

As for the secret of the seven stars that I saw on my right hand, and the seven golden lamps: the seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lamps that I saw are the seven churches.

Vision 2

1 “To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: These are the words of him who holds the seven

stars in his right hand and walks among the seven
golden lampstands:

2 "I know your works, your efforts, your patience,
and how you cannot stand evil people. You have
tested those who claim to be apostles but are not,
and have found them to be liars."

3 You have persevered and worked for my name
and have not grown weary.

4 But I have one thing against you: you have given
up the love you had at the beginning.

5 Therefore, remember from where you fell. Repent,
and do the works you were doing first. Otherwise, if
you do not repent, I will come to you quickly and
remove your lampstand from its place.

6. "You hate the practices of the Nicholas family,"
which I hate too.

7 Whoever has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit
says to the churches. To the one who overcomes, I
will grant to eat from the tree of life which is in the
paradise of Alaha [Allah].

8 “To the angel of the church in Smyrna write: These are the words of the First and the Last, who was dead and came to life.”

9 I know your deeds and your troubles, your poverty (though you are rich), and the blasphemy of those who claim to be Jews but are not, but are a synagogue of Satan.

10 Do not be afraid of what you will suffer. Satan will throw some of you into prison to be tempted, and you will suffer tribulations for ten days. Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life.

11 Whoever has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes will not be hurt by the second death.

12 “Write to the angel of the church in Pergamum: This is what the man with the two-edged sword says:

13 I know your deeds and the place where you live, where Satan has his throne. You hold fast to my name and have not denied my faith, even in the days when my faithful witness Antipas was killed among you, where Satan lives.

14 But I have some things against you, because some of you hold fast to the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block in the way of the Israelites, so that they would eat food sacrificed to idols and commit sexual immorality.

15 Likewise, there are some among you who hold to the teachings of the Nicolaitans, whom I hate.

16 Repent then, or I will come to you quickly and fight against them with the sword of my mouth.

17 Whoever has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To the one who overcomes, I will give some of the hidden manna to eat. I will also give him a white stone with a new name written on it, which no one knows except the one who receives it.

18 “Write to the angel of the church of Thyatira: These are the words of the Son of Alaha [Allah], who has eyes like flames and feet like burnished bronze.”

19 I know your works, your love, your service, your faith, and your perseverance, and that your latter works are greater than your former works.

20 But I have a small complaint against you:
because you allowed Jezebel, who claims to be a
prophetess, to teach my servants and entice them to
commit adultery and to eat food that was offered to
idols.

21 I gave her a chance to repent of her wickedness,
but she did not repent.

22 “I will put her to death, and those who have
committed adultery with her will suffer great distress
unless they repent of their deeds.”

23 I will put her children to death. Then all the
churches will know that I am the one who searches
hearts and minds, and I will reward each one of you
according to what you have done.

24 As for you—and I say this to the people of
Thyatira, to all who have not received this instruction
and do not know the schemes of the devil, as they
say—I will not lay any further burden on you.

25 Hold on to what you have until I come.

26 “But to the one who overcomes and keeps my works to the end, I will give authority over the nations.”

27 He will rule them with an iron rod, as one breaks pottery, just as I received it from my Father.

28 I will give him the Morning Star.

29 Whoever has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

Revelation 3

1 “To the angel of the church in Sardis write: ‘Thus says he who has seven spirits, seven halls, and seven stars: I know your deeds. You have a name in life, but you are dead.’”

2 Be on your guard, and hold on to what remains, which is about to die, because I have not found your works perfect before Alaha [Allah].

3 Remember how you received and heard these things; keep them in your minds and repent. If you

do not watch, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come.

4 There are few in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes; they will walk with me in white clothes, for they are worthy.

5 The one who overcomes will be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the book of life, but will confess his name before my Father and his angels.

6 Whoever has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

7 “To the angel of the church in Philadelphia write: This is what the Holy One, the True One, says, who has the key of David, who opens so that no one can shut, and shuts so that no one can open.”

8 I know your deeds. “Behold, I have set before you an open door which no one can shut, because you are weak in strength; yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name.”

9 “I will make those who claim to be Jews, but are in fact of Satan’s synagogue and are not, but are liars,

come and worship at your feet, and they will know
that I have loved you.”

10 Because you have kept my word by enduring, I
will also keep you from the hour of trouble that will
come on the whole world to test the inhabitants of
the earth.

11 Behold, I am coming quickly. Hold fast to what
you have, lest someone take your crown.

12 He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the
temple of my Alaha [Allah], and he shall never
depart from it. I will write on him the name of my
Alaha [Allah] and the name of the city of my Alaha
[Allah], the New Jerusalem, which comes down out
of heaven from my Alaha [Allah], and my own new
name.

13 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit
says to the churches.

14 To the angel of the church of the Laodiceans
write: These are the words of Amen, the faithful and
true witness, the beginning of Alaha [Allah]’s
creation.

15 I know your deeds, for you are neither cold nor
hot.

16 “I wish you were either hot or cold! 16 Therefore,
because you are lukewarm—neither hot nor cold—I
will spit you out of my mouth.”

17 For you say, “I am rich and have acquired wealth;
I need nothing.” But you do not realize that you are
pitiful, needy, poor, blind, and naked.

18 I advise you to buy from me gold refined by fire,
so that you may profit; white clothes to wear so that
your nakedness may not be exposed; and kohl for
your eyes so that you may see.

19 “I rebuke and discipline those I love; therefore be
deceived and repent.”

20 “Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If
anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will
come in and eat with him, and he with me.”

21 But to the one who overcomes, I will grant to sit
with me on my throne, just as I overcame and sat
with my Father on his throne.

22 “He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.”

Revelation 4

1 After this I looked, and behold, a door was opened in heaven, and I heard a voice calling to me like the sound of a trumpet, saying, “Come up here, and I will show you what must happen after this.”

2 Immediately I was in the Spirit, and behold, a throne was set up in heaven, and He was seated on it.

3 He who sat on the throne was like rubies and sapphires, and the rainbow surrounding the throne was like emeralds.

4 Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and I saw twenty-four elders sitting on the thrones, dressed in white robes, with crowns of gold on their heads.

5 From the throne came lightning, thunder, and voices. Before the throne were seven blazing lamps, which are the spirits of the seven Deities.

6 Before the throne was a sea of glass like crystal.
In the center of the throne and around it were four
living creatures, full of eyes on the front and the
back.

7 The first living creature resembled a lion, the
second resembled a calf, the third had a face like a
human face, and the fourth resembled a flying eagle.

8 These four living creatures, each with six wings
surrounding them on all sides, have eyes inside
them that never cease to say: “Holy, holy, holy is the
Lord Alaha [Allah] Almighty, who was, who is, and
who is to come.”

9 When living beings give glory, honor, and thanks
to Him who sits on the throne, the Living One forever
and ever,

10 The twenty-four elders bow down before him who
sits on the throne, and they bow down to him who
lives forever and ever. They lay their crowns before
the throne, saying:

11 “You are worthy, Lord, to receive glory, honor,
and power, for you created everything, and it exists
and was created by your will.”

Revelation 5

1 Then I saw on the right of him who was seated on the throne a scroll on which was written both inside and out, sealed with seven seals.

2 Then I saw a great angel calling out in a loud voice, “Who is worthy to open the scroll and to break its seals?”

3 But no one in heaven or on earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll or even look inside it.

4 And I wept bitterly, because there was no one worthy to open the manuscript and read it, or even to look inside it.

5 Then one of the elders said to me, “Do not weep. Look, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has triumphed; he has opened the scroll and broken its seven seals.”

6 Then I saw a Lamb standing as though it had been slain, in the midst of the throne and the four living

creatures and in the midst of the elders. It had seven horns and seven eyes, which are the spirits of the seven Elahs sent out into all the earth.

7 Then he went and took the ladder from the right hand of him who was seated on the throne.

8 When the Lamb went up the ladder, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb. Each of them had a harp and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints.

9 And they sang a new song, saying, “You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood you have purchased for your Alaha [Allah] men from every tribe and language and people and nation.”

10 You have made us kings and priests to serve our Alaha [Allah], and we shall reign on the earth.

11 Then I looked and heard the voice of many angels around the throne, and of every living creature, and of the elders, tens of thousands upon tens of thousands and thousands upon thousands.

12 saying aloud, “Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing.”

13 And I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea and all that is in them saying, “To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and dominion for ever and ever.”

14 Then the four living creatures said, “Amen.” And the twenty-four elders worshiped Him who lives forever and ever.

Revelation 6

1 And I saw, when the lamb opened one of the seven seals, I heard one of the four living creatures say in a voice like thunder, “Come and see!”

2 Then I looked, and there was a white horse, and its rider had a bow, and he was given a crown, and he went out triumphant, triumphant.

3 When the second seal was opened, I heard the second living being say, “Come and see!”

4 Then another horse came out, red in color, and its rider was given power to take peace from the earth and to make people kill one another, and he was given a great sword.

5 When the third seal was opened, I heard the third living being say, "Come and see!" So I looked, and there was a black horse, and its rider had a scale in his hand.

6 And I heard a voice from among the four living creatures saying, "One hundred pounds of wheat for a denarius, and three hundred pounds of barley for a denarius. Do not harm the oil or the wine."

7 When the fourth seal was opened, I heard the voice of the fourth living being say, "Come and see!"

8 Then I looked, and behold, a red horse! Its rider was called Death, and Hades followed him. They were given dominion over a quarter of the earth, to kill with the sword, famine, death, and the beasts of the earth.

9 When he opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the spirits of those who had been slain for the

word of Alaha [Allah] and for the testimony they had given.

10 Then they cried out in a loud voice, saying, “How long, O Lord, Holy and True, until you judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?”

11 So they were given white robes and told to rest a little while until the number of their fellow servants and brothers who would be killed as they were killed was complete.

12 Then I saw him open the sixth seal, and behold, there was a great earthquake. The sun became black like sackcloth, and the moon became like blood.

13 And the stars of heaven fell to the earth as figs fall when a strong wind shakes them.

14 The heavens were torn apart like a ladder, and every mountain and island was removed from its place.

15 So the kings of the earth, the nobles, the rich, the princes, the powerful, every slave, and every free

man hid in caves and among the rocks of the
mountains,

16 Saying to the mountains and rocks, “Fall on us
and hide us from the face of him who sits on the
throne and from the wrath of the Lamb.”

17 For the day of his great wrath has come. Who
can stand?

Revelation 7

1 Then I saw four angels standing at the four
corners of the earth, holding back the four winds of
the earth, so that no wind would blow on the land or
on the sea or on any tree.

2 Then I saw another angel coming up from the
rising of the sun, bearing the seal of the living Alaha
[Allah].

3 Then he called out in a loud voice to the four
angels who had been given authority to harm the
land and the sea, saying, “Do not harm the land, the
sea, or the trees until we have sealed the servants
of our Alaha [Allah] on their foreheads.”

4 I heard the number of those sealed: 144,000 from each of the tribes of Israel.

5 Twelve thousand from the tribe of Judah, twelve thousand from the tribe of Reuben, and twelve thousand from the tribe of Gad,

6 Twelve thousand from the tribe of Asher, twelve thousand from the tribe of Naphtali, twelve thousand from the tribe of Manasseh, and

Seven thousand and twelve thousand were from the tribe of Simeon. Twelve thousand were from the tribe of Levi. Twelve thousand were from the tribe of Issachar.

8 Of the tribe of Zebulun, twelve thousand were sealed. Of the tribe of Joseph, twelve thousand were sealed. Of the tribe of Benjamin, twelve thousand were sealed.

9 Then I looked, and behold, a great multitude, which no one could number, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, holding palm branches in their hands.

10 And they cry out loudly, saying, "Salvation belongs to our Alaha [Allah] who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"

11 All the angels were standing around the throne, as were the elders and the four living creatures. They worshiped the throne and served Alaha [Allah].

12 saying, "Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and majesty be to our Alaha [Allah] forever!" Amen.

13 Then one of the elders asked me, "Who are these people who are wearing white clothes, and where did they come from?"

14 I answered him, "Sir, you know." He said to me, "These are the ones who have come out of the great tribulation. They have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb."

15 Therefore they are before the throne of Alaha [Allah], serving him night and day in his temple, and he who sits on the throne dwells above them.

16 They will never again go hungry or thirsty, nor will they be beaten by the sun or suffer from the heat.

17 For the Lamb in the midst of the throne will be their Shepherd, and will lead them to springs of living water, and Alaha [Allah] will wipe every tear from their eyes.

Revelation 8

1 When the seventh seal was opened, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour.

2 Then I saw the seven angels standing before the altar, and they were given seven trumpets.

3 Then another angel came and stood at the altar, holding a golden censer. Much incense was given to him to offer, with the prayers of all the saints, on the golden altar before the throne.

4 And the smoke of incense and the prayers of the saints went up before their beards from the hand of the angel.

5 Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw it on the earth. There were shouts, thunder, lightning, and an earthquake.

6 Then the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared to blow them.

7 Then the first angel blew his trumpet, and hail and fire mixed with blood came down and were hurled down on the earth. A third of the trees were burned up, and all the green grass was burned up.

8 Then the second angel blew his trumpet, and it was as if a great mountain of fire was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea was turned to blood.

9. One-third of the living creatures in the sea died, and one-third of the ships were wrecked.

10 Then the third angel blew his trumpet, and a great star, blazing like a flame, fell from heaven and fell on a third of the rivers and springs.

11 The name of the star that disappeared was Wormwood. A third of the water turned to wormwood, and many people died because of the bitterness of the water.

12 Then the fourth angel blew his trumpet, and a third of the sun, a third of the moon, and a third of the stars flew away. A third of them became dark,

and the light of a third of the day and the night was
extinguished.

13 Then I looked and heard an angel flying through the air saying in a loud voice, “Woe, woe, woe to the inhabitants of the earth because of the voices of the three remaining angels, who are about to blow their trumpets.”

Revelation 9

1 Then the fifth angel blew his trumpet, and I saw a star fall from heaven to earth. And the key to hell was given to him.

2 Then he opened hell, and smoke rose out of it like the smoke of a great furnace, and the sun and the sky were darkened by the smoke.

3 And out of the smoke came locusts on the earth, and they were given strength like the strength given to scorpions.

4 They were told not to harm any plant of the earth or any green thing or tree, except those on whose foreheads Alaha [Allah]’s seal had been placed.

5 They were permitted not to kill them, but to torture them for five months. Their torment was like the torment of a scorpion when it stings a person.

6 In those days people will seek death and will not find it, and will desire death and death will flee from them.

7 The locusts looked like warhorses, with crowns of gold on their heads and faces resembling human faces.

8. They had hair like a woman's and teeth like a lion's fangs.

9 They wore armor like iron armor, and the sound of their wings was like the sound of many chariots of horses speeding into battle.

10 It had tails like scorpions, and in its tails were stinging needles. It had the ability to torture people for five months.

11 The angel of the abyss reigns over him. His name in Hebrew is Abaddon, and in Greek Apollo.

12 The first woes have passed, and two more will follow.

13 Then the sixth angel blew the trumpet, and I heard one sound from the four golden horns of the altar before the hymns.

14 Then he said to the sixth angel who was holding the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates."

15 So the four angels who had been prepared for the hour, day, month, and year to kill a third of mankind were released.

16. The number of horsemen was two hundred million, and I heard their number myself.

17 This is how I saw the horses in the vision, and the riders on them. They were wearing breastplates of fire, blue, and sulfur. The heads of the horses were like the heads of lions, and out of their mouths came fire, smoke, and sulfur.

18 of these three, that is, one-third of mankind, were killed by fire, smoke, and brimstone that came out of their mouths.

19 For their strength was in their mouths and their tails; for their ears were like the ears of snakes, and they had heads with which they inflicted harm.

20 But the rest of the people, who were not destroyed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands. They no longer worshiped demons and idols made of gold, silver, bronze, stone, and wood, which neither see nor hear nor walk.

21 They did not repent of the murders they had committed, nor of their sorcery, nor of their sexual immorality, nor of their thefts.

Revelation 10

1 Then I saw another mighty angel coming down from heaven, clothed with a cloud, with a rainbow on his head, his face like the sun, and his feet like pillars of fire.

2 He had in his hand a small, unrolled scroll. He put his right foot on the sea and his left foot on the land.

3 And he roared with a loud voice like the roar of a lion. And after he roared, the seven thunders spoke with their voices.

4 After the seven thunders had spoken, I was about to write them down, but I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, "Seal what the seven thunders have spoken, and do not write it down."

5 Then I saw the angel standing on the sea and the land, and he raised his hand to heaven.

6 And I swear by Him who lives forever and ever, the Creator of the heavens and all that is in them, the earth and all that is in it, and the sea and all that is in it, that "there will be no more time."

7 But in the days when the voice of the seventh angel is heard, when he intends to blow his trumpet, the mystery of Alaha [Allah] will be fulfilled, as he declared to his servants the prophets.

8 Then the voice I heard from heaven spoke to me again, saying, "Go and take the little ladder that is open in the hand of the angel who stands on the sea and the land."

9 So I went to the angel and said to him, "Give me the little scroll." He said to me, "Take it and eat it; it will make your stomach bitter, but it will be as sweet as honey in your mouth."

10 Then I took the little scroll from the angel's hand and ate it, and it was as sweet as honey in my mouth. But after I ate it, my stomach became bitter.

11 Then he said to me, "You must prophesy again about many peoples, nations, languages, and kings."

Revelation 11

1 Then I was given a staff like a crutch, and the angel stood and said to me, "Get up and measure the temple of Alaha [Allah] and the altar and those who worship in it."

2 But do not measure the outer courtyard of the temple, for it has been given to the Gentiles, and they will trample the holy city underfoot for forty-two months.

3 I will give authority to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for 1,260 days while wearing sackcloth.

4 These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands that stand before the Lord of the earth.

5. Whoever tries to harm them will have fire come out of their mouths and consume their enemies. Whoever tries to harm them will be killed in this way.

6 These two men have the power to close the heavens so that it does not rain during their prophecy. They also have the power to turn water into blood, and they will strike the earth with every kind of calamity whenever they wish.

7 When they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes out of the tomb will fight them, overcome them, and kill them.

8 And their bodies were laid out in the main street of the great city, which is spiritually called Sodom and Egypt, where our Lord was also crucified.

9 For three and a half days, people of all peoples, tribes, languages and nations looked at their corpses but would not allow them to be buried.

10 The inhabitants of the earth were glad and rejoiced over them, and exchanged gifts, because these two prophets had tormented the inhabitants of the earth.

11 After three and a half days, the breath of life from Alaha [Allah] entered them, and they awoke. Great fear fell on those who were watching them.

12 Then they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, "Come up here." So they went up to heaven in the clouds, and their enemies saw them.

13 At that very hour there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city was destroyed, and seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake. The rest were afraid and glorified Alaha [Allah], Lord of heaven.

14 The second calamity has passed, and the third calamity is coming soon.

15 Then the seventh angel blew his trumpet, and loud voices were heard in heaven saying, “The kingdoms of the world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of his Messiah, and he will reign for ever and ever.”

16 As for the twenty-four elders who were sitting on their thrones, they bowed down before their Alaha [Allah] and worshiped him.

17 They said, “We thank you, Lord Almighty Alaha [Allah], who is, who was, and who is to come, for you have taken your great authority and have begun to reign.”

18 “The nations were angry, and your anger came upon them. The time has come to judge the dead, to punish your servants the prophets and the saints, and all who fear your name, both small and great, and to destroy those who have corrupted the earth.”

19 Then the temple of Alaha [Allah] in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant was uncovered in his temple. There were flashes of lightning, thunder, an earthquake, and great hail.

Revelation 12

- 1 Then a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet and on her head a crown of twelve stars.
2. She was pregnant and screamed in pain during childbirth.
- 3 Another sign appeared in the sky: a great red dragon with seven heads and ten horns, and on its heads were seven crowns.
4. Its tail swept away a third of the stars in the sky and threw them to the ground. The dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, ready to swallow her child as soon as she delivered it.
- 5 She gave birth to a male child, who was destined to rule all nations with an iron scepter. Her son was exalted to her Alaha [Allah] and to his throne.
- 6 So the woman fled into the wilderness, to a place her sisters had prepared for her, where she was fed for 1260 days.

7 Then war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought the dragon, and the dragon and his angels fought the dragon.

But they were not strong enough, and there was no longer a place for them in heaven.

The great dragon, that ancient serpent called Satan or Iblis, who deceives the whole world, was cast down to Earth along with his angels.

10 Then I heard a loud voice in heaven saying, “Now salvation and power, the kingdom and authority of our Alaha [Allah] have come, for the accuser of our brothers and sisters, who accuses them before our Alaha [Allah] night and day, has been driven out.”

11 But they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives to the point of death.

12 Therefore rejoice, you heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea, because the devil has come down to you in great wrath, because he knows that his time is short.

13 When the dragon saw that he was hurled to the ground, he pursued the woman who had given birth to the child.

14 As for the woman, she was given the wings of a great eagle, so that she could fly into the wilderness to her place, where she would be kept from the serpent for a time and a time and half a time.

15 Then the snake spewed out of its mouth water like a river, after the woman, to sweep her away.

16 Then the earth helped the woman, and opened its mouth and swallowed up the river that the dragon had vomited out of his mouth.

17 Then the dragon became angry with the woman and went to fight against the rest of her offspring, those who keep Alaha [Allah]'s commandments and hold fast to the testimony of Yeshua [Isa] Christ.

Revelation 13

1 Then I stood on the sands of the sea, and I saw a monster coming up out of the sea. It had seven heads and ten horns, and on its horns were ten crowns, and on its heads were blasphemous names.

2 The beast I saw resembled a leopard, but its feet were like a bear's, and its mouth like a lion's. The dragon had given it its strength, its throne, and its great power.

3 I saw one of its heads as though it had been slain, and its fatal wound was healed. And all the earth marveled at the beast.

4 They worshiped the dragon, who had given the beast dominion; and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast? Who is able to make war with it?"

5 I was given a mouth to say great things and blasphemies, and I was given authority to do so for forty-two months.

6 Then she opened her mouth to blaspheme against her Alaha [Allah], to blaspheme against his name and his dwelling place and against those who dwell in heaven.

7 And I was given authority to fight against the saints and to overcome them; and I was given authority over every tribe, language, and nation.

8 All the inhabitants of the earth will worship him, those whose names were not written in the Lamb's book of life from the beginning of creation. 9 He who has ears, let him hear! 10 He who gathers captives will be taken captive, and he who kills with the sword will be killed by the sword. This is the patience and faith of Alaha [Allah]'s saints.

11 Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth. It had two horns like a lamb's, and it spoke like a dragon.

12 He exercised all the authority of the first beast before him, and made the earth and its inhabitants worship the first beast, who was healed of his fatal wound.

13 He performed great signs, even bringing down fire from heaven on the earth in the sight of the people.

14 He deceives the inhabitants of the earth by the signs that he was given to perform before the beast, and he commands them to make an image of the beast that was wounded by the sword and lived.

15 And I was given the power to breathe life into the image of the beast, so that the image would speak and kill all who would not worship it.

16 He will cause all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to be marked on their right hands or on their foreheads.

17 No one may buy or sell unless it bears the mark, or the name of the beast, or its name number.

18 Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man, and his number is 666.

Revelation 14

1 Then I looked, and behold, a lamb was standing on Mount Zion, and with it 144,000, on whose foreheads was written the name of its Father.

2 And I heard a sound from heaven, like the sound of rushing waters and like the sound of great thunder. And I heard a sound like the sound of harpists playing their harps.

3 And they sang a new song before the throne and before the four living creatures and the elders. And no one was able to learn the song except the 144,000 who were redeemed from the earth.

These are the ones whom women did not defile, for they were pure. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These are the ones redeemed from among mankind, the firstfruits of Alaha [Allah], the Lamb.

5 No deceit was found in their mouths, for they are innocent before the throne of Alaha [Allah].

6 Then I saw another angel flying through the air, carrying the eternal gospel to preach to the inhabitants of the earth, every nation, tribe, language, and people.

7 And he cried out in a loud voice, saying, “Fear Alaha [Allah] and glorify him, for the hour of his judgment has come. Worship him who made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and the springs of water.”

8 Then another angel followed, saying, “Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great city, because she made all nations drink the wine of her deadly fornication.”

9 Then a third angel followed them, saying in a loud voice, “If anyone worships the beast and its image, and kisses its mark on his forehead or on his hand,

10 He will also drink the wine of Alaha [Allah]’s wrath, which is poured out pure into the cup of his indignation. He will be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and the Lamb.

11 The smoke of their torment will rise forever and ever. There will be no rest, neither by day nor by night, for those who worship the beast and its image, or for anyone who accepts the mark of its name.

12 This is the patience of the saints, who keep the commandments of Alaha [Allah] and the faith of Yeshua [Isa].

13 Then I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, “Write: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.” “Yes,” says the Spirit, “so that they

may rest from their labors, and their deeds may follow them.”

14 Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and on the cloud sat a person who looked like the Son of Man, and on his head was a golden crown, and in his hand was a sharp sickle.

15 Then another angel came out of the temple and called out in a loud voice to him who was sitting on the cloud, saying, “Put down your sickle and reap, for it is time to reap, because the ground is dry.”

16 Then he who was sitting on the cloud threw down his sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped.

17 Then another angel went out of the temple into heaven, carrying a sharp sickle.

18 Then another angel came out of the altar, who had authority over the fire, and called out in a loud voice to the one who had the sharp sickle, saying, “Put down your sharp sickle and gather the grapes from the vineyard of the land, for its grapes are ripe.”

19 Then the angel threw down his sickle on the ground and uprooted the vine from the ground and

threw it into the great winepress of Alaha [Allah]’s
wrath.

20 The grapes were pressed outside the city, and
the blood flowed from them up to the bridles of the
horses, at a distance of one thousand six hundred
stadia.

Revelation 15

1 Then I saw another great sign in heaven: seven
angels who had the seven last plagues, because
Alaha [Allah]’s wrath had been done on them.

2 And I saw what looked like a sea of glass mixed
with fire, and those who had overcome the beast—
its image, its likeness, and the number of its name—
standing on the sea of glass, holding harps of their
beards.

3 And they sang the song of Moses, the servant of
Alaha [Allah], and the song of the Lamb, saying:
“Great and wonderful are your works, O Lord Alaha
[Allah] Almighty! Just and true are your ways, O King
of the saints!”

4 Who is there who will not fear you, Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come to you and worship before you, for your judgments have been declared.

5 Then I looked, and behold, the structure of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened.

6 The seven angels came out of the temple, and they had the seven plagues with them. They were dressed in fine linen garments, and around their necks were gold belts.

7 Then one of the four living creatures gave the seven angels seven golden vessels filled with the wrath of Alaha [Allah] who lives forever.

8 The temple was filled with smoke from the glory and power of Alaha [Allah], and no one could enter the temple until the seven plagues of the angels were completed.

Revelation 16

1 Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, "Go and pour out the bowls of Alaha [Allah]'s wrath on the earth."

2 Then the first angel went and poured out his jar of wrath on the ground, and painful sores appeared on the people who had the mark of the beast and who worshiped its image.

3 Then the second angel poured out his jar of wrath on the sea, and it became blood like the blood of a dead person, and every living creature in the sea died.

4 The third angel poured out his jar of wrath on the rivers and springs, and they turned to blood.

5 Then I heard the angel of the waters say, "You are just, O Alaha [Allah], who is and who was and who is to come, for you have judged so."

6 "Because they shed the blood of the saints and prophets, I made them drink blood, because they deserved it."

7 Then I heard another voice from the altar saying,
“Yes, Lord Almighty Alaha [Allah]! Your judgments
are true and just.”

8 The fourth angel poured out his anger on the sun,
and was given the power to set people on fire.

9 So the people were burned with a great fire, and
they blasphemed the name of their Alaha [Allah],
who had power over these calamities, but they did
not repent or glorify him.

10 Then the fifth angel poured out his wrath on the
throne of the beast, and his kingdom was darkened.
They bit their tongues in agony.

11 Because of their pains and sores, they
blasphemed against the Alaha [Allah] of heaven, but
they did not repent of what they had done.

12 Then the sixth angel poured out his jar of wrath
on the great river Euphrates, and its waters dried up,
to make way for the kings who are from the east of
the sun.

13 I saw three unclean spirits like frogs coming out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

14 They are evil spirits who perform miracles. They go out to the kings of the world and to all parts of the world to gather them for the battle of that great day of Almighty Alaha [Allah].

15 “Look, I am coming like a thief. Blessed is the one who stays awake and keeps his clothes on, so that he will not go naked and be exposed.”

16 Then he gathered them together to the place which in Hebrew is called Armageddon.

17 Then the seventh angel poured out the cup of his wrath into the air, and a loud voice came from the temple in heaven, from the throne, saying, “It is done!”

18 And there was shouting, thunder, lightning, and a great earthquake, the like of which has not been seen since man has been on the earth.

19 The great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. When the great Babylon

was mentioned before their Alaha [Allah]s, he poured out the cup of his wrath upon her.

20. Every island disappeared, and the mountains no longer existed.

21 Then great hail, weighing about a measure, fell from the sky on the people. So the people blasphemed against their Alaha [Allah]s because of the plague of hail, for the plague was great.

Revelation 17

1 Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came to me and said, “Come, I will show you the judgment of the great prostitute who sits by the many waters,

2 With whom the kings of the earth committed adultery, and the inhabitants of the earth became drunk with the wine of her adultery.

3 Then the Spirit carried me into the wilderness, and I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast covered with blasphemous names, having seven heads and ten horns.

4 The woman was dressed in purple and scarlet, and adorned with gold, precious stones, and pearls. In her hand was a golden cup filled with the filth and impurities of her fornication.

5 On her forehead was written the name: "Secret: Babylon the Great, Mother of Whores and Abominations of the Earth."

6 I saw the woman drunk with the blood of the saints and the blood of those who were martyred for Yeshua [Isa], and I was greatly astonished at what I saw.

7 Then the angel said to me, "Why are you surprised? I will tell you the secret of the woman and the beast that carries her, which has seven heads and ten horns."

8 The beast you saw was, and is not, and is about to come out of the grave and go to destruction. The inhabitants of the earth, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life since the creation of the world, will be astonished when they see the beast, that it was, and is not, but is now.

9 This is wisdom: The seven heads are seven mountains on which a woman sits.

10 There were seven kings: five of them fell, one rose, and the other has not yet come. When he comes, he must stay a little while.

11 The beast that was and is not now is the eighth; he is one of the seven, and he is about to perish.

12 The ten horns you saw are ten kings who have not yet received a kingship, but will receive their authority as kings for one hour with the beast.

13 These are of one mind, and they will surrender their power and authority to the beast.

14 These will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings. Those who are with Him are the called, the chosen, and the faithful.

15 Then he said to me, "The waters you saw where the prostitute sat are peoples, multitudes, nations, and languages."

16 As for the ten horns that you saw on the beast, they will hate the prostitute and make her desolate

and naked; they will eat her flesh and burn her with
fire.

17 For Alaha [Allah] has put it in their hearts to do his will, to be of one mind, and to hand over their kingdom to the beast, so that the words of Alaha [Allah] may be fulfilled.

18 "The woman you saw is the great city that has dominion over the kings of the earth."

Revelation 18

1 Then I saw another angel coming down from heaven, having great authority, and the earth shone with his glory.

2 Then he cried out loudly, saying, "Fallen, fallen is great Babylon! She has become a haunt of demons, a haunt of every unclean spirit, a haunt of every unclean and detestable bird."

3 For all nations have drunk of the wine of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth have become rich from her many pleasures.

4 Then I heard another voice from heaven saying,
“Come out of her, my people, or you will share in her
sins and none of her plagues will strike you.”

5 For her sins have reached to the heavens, and her
Alaha [Allah]s have remembered her iniquities.

6 Repay her as she has repaid you; give her double
what she gave you, and mix double the amount of
wine into the cup in which she mixed it.

7 For as much as she boasted and lived in luxury,
she would suffer great pain and sorrow. For she said
in her heart, “I am a queen, not a widow, and I will
never see sorrow again.”

8 Therefore, in one day disasters will befall it: death,
grief, and famine; and it will be burned with fire, for
the Lord Alaha [Allah] who judges it is mighty.

9 "The kings of the earth will weep and wail over her
when they see the smoke of her burning."

10 They will stand far off, terrified at her torment,
and will say, “Woe, woe to Babylon, the great
fortified city! For in one hour your judgment has
come!”

11 The merchants of the earth will weep and wail over it, because no one will buy their merchandise anymore.

12 pieces of gold and silver, precious stones, pearls, fine linen, purple, silk, crimson, all kinds of fir wood, all ivory works, all works of the finest wood, bronze, iron, and marble.

13 Cinnamon, incense, spices, frankincense, wine, oil, flour, wheat, cattle, sheep, horses, chariots, human bodies, and human souls.

14 The fruits of your lust have gone from you; all that is rich and beautiful has gone from you, and you will not find it again.

15 But those who traded in these things and profited from them will stand far off, afraid of their punishment, weeping and wailing.

16 They will say, “Woe, woe to the great city that was clothed in fine linen, purple, and scarlet, and adorned with gold, precious stones, and pearls!”

17 In one hour all these riches will be destroyed!
Every captain, every crew, every sailor, and every
navigator will stand at a distance.

18 When they see the smoke rising from its fire, they
will cry out, “What city is like this great city?”

19 They will throw dust on their heads and cry out,
weep and wail, saying, “Woe, woe! The great city
whose treasures were useful to all who had ships at
sea has been destroyed in one hour!”

20 Rejoice over her, you heavens, and you holy
apostles and prophets, for the Lord has condemned
her as you have condemned him.

21 Then a mighty angel picked up a stone like a
great millstone and threw it into the sea, saying,
“With this power Babylon, the great city, will be
overthrown and will no longer exist.”

22 No longer will the sound of harpists, singers, flute
players, or trumpet players be heard among you; no
more instrument makers will be found among you,
nor will the sound of a millstone be heard among
you.

No lamp will shine in you, nor will the voice of bridegroom and bride be heard in you. For your merchants were the rulers of the earth, and by your charms all the nations were led astray.

It contained the blood of prophets and saints, and the blood of all those who were killed on earth.

Revelation 19

1 Then I heard a loud voice from a great multitude in heaven saying, “Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our Alaha [Allah],

2 For his judgments are true and just, since he condemned the great prostitute who corrupted the earth with her prostitution, and avenged the blood of his servants on her hand.

3 They also said, “Hallelujah! Its smoke will rise forever.”

4 Then the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures bowed down to their Alaha [Allah] who was seated on the throne, saying, “Amen! Hallelujah!”

5 Then a voice came from the throne, saying, “Bless our Alaha [Allah], all you his servants, you who fear him, both small and great.”

6 Then I heard the voice of a great multitude, the sound of rushing waters, and the sound of a great thunder, saying, “Hallelujah! For the Lord Alaha [Allah] Almighty reigns.”

7 Therefore let us rejoice and be glad and give glory to him, because the wedding feast of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready.

8 I have been given fine linen, shining and clean, for fine linen symbolizes the righteousness of Alaha [Allah]’s saints.

9 Then he said to me, “Write: Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb!” And he said, “These are the faithful words of Alaa.”

10 So I knelt down at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, “See, do not do that! I am a servant like you and your brothers who bear witness to Yeshua [Isa]. Worship Alaha [Allah], for the testimony of Yeshua [Isa] is the spirit of prophecy.”

11 Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse! The one sitting on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he judges and makes war.

12 His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns, and on him is written a name that no one knows except him.

13 He was wearing a robe stained with blood, and his name was Kalimat Alaa.

14 The heavenly host followed him on white horses, dressed in fine linen, white and clean.

15 Out of his mouth came a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations; he will rule them with an iron scepter, treading the winepress of the wrath and anger of Alaha [Allah] Almighty.

16 On his robe and on his thigh was written his name: "King of kings and Lord of lords."

17 Then I saw one angel standing in the sun, and he called out in a loud voice to all the birds that fly in the air, saying, "Come, gather together to the great banquet of Alaha [Allah],

18 To eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of commanders, the flesh of the mighty, the flesh of horses and their riders, and the flesh of every human being, whether free or slave, small or great.

19 Then I saw the beast and the kings of the earth with their armies gathered together to fight against the rider on the horse and his army.

20 So they seized the beast, and with him the false prophet who performed signs in its presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and worshiped its image. The two of them were thrown alive into the lake of fire burning with sulfur.

21 As for the rest, the knight on horse killed them with his sword, and the birds ate their flesh.

Vision 20

1 Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven,
holding in his hand the key to Hades and a great
chain.

2 So he seized the dragon, that ancient serpent,
who is the devil or Satan, and bound him for a
thousand years.

3 Then he threw him into the abyss, and shut and
sealed it, so that he could no longer deceive the
nations until the thousand years were over. After
that, he must be let out for a short time.

4 Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and the
judgment was carried out. I also saw the souls of
those who had been slain for their testimony to
Yeshua [Isa] and to the word of Alaha [Allah], and
who had not worshiped the beast or its image, nor
received its mark on their foreheads or on their
hands. They lived and reigned with Christ for a
thousand years.

5 But the rest of the dead were not resurrected until
a thousand years had passed. This is the first
resurrection.

6 Blessed are those who are sanctified and share in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of Alaha [Allah] and of Christ, and will reign with him for a thousand years.

7 Then, when the thousand years are over, Satan will be released from his prison.

8 He will go out to deceive the nations in the four corners of the earth—Gog and Magog—to gather them for war. Their number will be like the grains of sand on the seashore.

9 They will advance across the expanse of the land and besiege the camp of the people of Alaha and the city they love. But fire will come down from the sky from Alaha and burn them.

10 As for the devil who deceived them, he was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet are. They will be tormented there night and day forever and ever.

11 Then I saw a great throne, white in color, and the One who sat on it. From him the earth and the sky fled away, and no place was found for them.

12 I saw the dead, both small and great, standing before their Creator. The books were opened, and another book was opened, the book of life. The dead were judged according to their deeds, as it is written in the books.

13 Then the sea brought out the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades brought out the dead who were in them. And each one was judged according to his deeds.

14 And Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

15 And everyone whose name was not found written in the book of life was thrown into the lake of fire.

Revelation 21

1 Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more.

2 Then I, John, saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from Alaha [Allah], prepared as a bride adorned for her bridegroom.

3 Then I heard a loud voice from heaven saying,
“Look, the dwelling place of Alaha [Allah] is with the
people, and he will dwell with them, and they will be
his people, and Alaha [Allah] himself will be with
them as their Alaha [Allah].”

4 He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there
will be no death, no sorrow, no crying, no pain,
because the old order will be gone.

5 Then he who sat on the throne said, “Behold, I am
making all things new.” And he said to me, “Write
this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.”

6 Then he said to me, “It is done! I am the Alpha and
the Omega, the beginning and the end. Whoever is
thirsty, I will give them something to drink from the
spring of the water of life without cost.”

7 The one who overcomes will inherit all things, and
I will be their Alaha [Allah], and they will be my
children.

8 But the cowards, the unbelievers, the wicked, the
murderers, the sexually immoral, the sorcerers, the
idolaters, and all liars will end up in the lake of fire
and brimstone. This is the second death.

9 Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues came to me and said, “Come, I will show you the bride, the wife of the Lamb.”

10 Then the Spirit carried me up to a great, high mountain and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from its height.

11 In it was the glory of Alaha [Allah], and its brilliance was like the brilliance of precious stones, like rubies and crystal.

12 It had a great, high wall with twelve gates, and on the gates were twelve angels. On them were written the names of the twelve tribes of Israel.

13 There were three gates on the east side, three on the north side, three on the south side, and three on the west side.

14 The city wall had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

15 The one who was speaking to me had a golden staff with which he measured the city, its gates, and its wall.

16 The city was square in shape, its length equal to its width. He measured the city with a stick, and the distance was twelve thousand cubits. The whole city was equal in length, width, and height.

17 He measured its wall: 144 cubits, the cubit of a man (that is, an angel).

18 The wall was made of jasper, and the city was of pure gold, clear as glass.

19 The foundations of the city wall were decorated with all kinds of precious stones. The first foundation was made of jasper, the second of sapphire, the third of carnelian, and the fourth of emerald.

The fifth is red agate, the sixth is red agate, the seventh is peridot, the eighth is lapis lazuli, the ninth is blue sapphire, the tenth is green agate, the eleventh is blue agate, and the twelfth is amethyst.

21 The twelve gates were made of pearls, each gate made of a single pearl. The city street was made of pure gold, as clear as glass.

22 I did not see a temple in it, for the Lord Alaha [Allah] Almighty and the Lamb are its temple.

23 The city does not need the sun or the moon to give it light, for the glory of Alaha [Allah] gives it light, and the Lamb is its lamp.

24 The redeemed people will walk in her light, and the kings of the earth will come to her in their glory and honor.

25. Its doors will not be closed during the day, because there will be no night.

26 The nations will come to it in their glory and honor.

27 Nothing unclean will enter it, and no one will do anything detestable or evil, except those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

Revelation 22

1 Then he showed me the river of the water of life,
clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of Alaha
[Allah] and of the Lamb.

2 In the middle of her street, on both sides of the
river, stood the Tree of Life, bearing twelve kinds of
fruit, and bearing fruit every month. Its leaves are a
cure for the nations.

3. There will be no more curses. The throne of Alaha
[Allah] will be the Lamb, and his servants will serve
him.

4 They will see his face, and his name will be written
on their foreheads.

5 There will be no more night; they will not need a
lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord Alaha [Allah]
will give them light. They will reign forever.

6 Then he said to me, “These words are true and
faithful. The Lord, the Alaha [Allah] of the holy
prophets, has sent his angel to show his servants
what will soon happen.”

7 “I am coming soon! Blessed is the one who keeps
the words of the prophecy of this book.”

8 I am John, who saw and heard these things. When
I heard and saw them, I fell at the feet of the angel
who showed them to me.

9 He said to me, "See, do not do that! I am a servant
with you and with your brothers the prophets and
with those who keep the words of this book. Worship
Alaha [Allah]."

10 He also said to me, "Do not seal up the words of
the prophecy of this book, for the time is near."

11 Let the wicked continue to do evil, let the unclean
continue to be unclean, let the righteous continue to
be righteous, and let the saints continue to be holy.

12 "Behold, I am coming quickly, and you must run
with me, so that you may give to each one according
to his work."

13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning
and the end, the first and the last.

14 Blessed are those who keep his commandments,
for they have the right to the tree of life, and they will
enter the city through its gates.

15 But outside of it are dogs, sorcerers, adulterers, murderers, idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices lying.

16 “I am Yeshua [Isa], and I have sent my angel to testify to you about these things concerning the churches. I am the root and the seed of David, the bright morning star.”

17 The Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” Let him who hears say, “Come!” Let him who is thirsty come, and let him who is thirsty receive the gift of the water of life freely.

18 For I warn everyone who hears the prophecy of this book: if anyone adds anything to these words, Alaha [Allah] will add to that person the calamities described in this book.

19 But if anyone takes away anything from the words of this book of prophecy, Alaha [Allah] will take away from that person his share in the tree of life and in the holy city described in this book.

20 The witness to these things says, “Yes, I am coming soon.” Amen. Come, Lord Yeshua [Isa].

21 May the grace of our Lord Yeshua [Isa] Christ be
with you all. Amen.
